(2) Paragraph 17

If there are some potential “appropriate measures” for “additional sources of information and enhanced verification procedures”, please provide specific examples.

2. “IV. Legal persons and arrangements and beneficial ownership”

(1) Paragraphs 22, 23, 29 and 30
